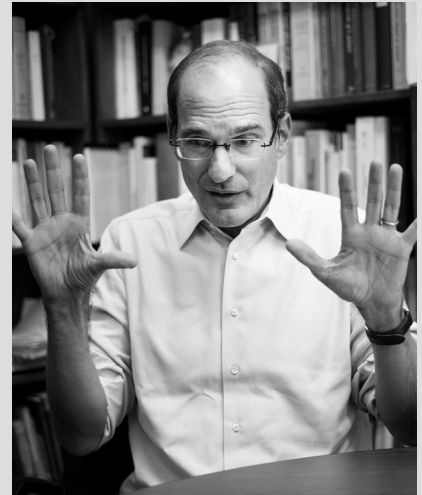
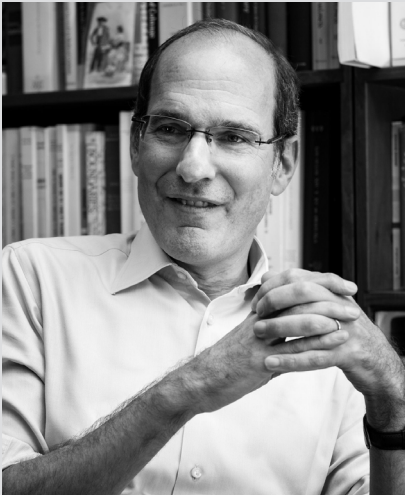


A History of Race and Religion

David Nirenberg received his BA from Yale in 1986 and his doctorate from Princeton University in 1992. His books include *Communities of Violence: Persecution of Minorities in the Middle Ages*, *Anti-Judaism: The Western Tradition*, *Neighboring Faiths: Christianity, Islam, and Judaism Medieval and Modern*, and *Aesthetic Theology and its Enemies: Judaism in Christian Painting, Poetry, and Politics*. His most recent book, *Uncountable: A Philosophical History of Number and Humanity from Antiquity to the Present*, was written in collaboration with his father Ricardo Nirenberg, a mathematician. His current project, from which these lectures are drawn, is tentatively entitled *Adam's Seed: A World History of Race and Religion from the Neolithic to the Present*.
